NATIONAL WOMEN SAFETY POLICY

- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the status in this regard; and**
- (c) the steps taken for making the draft of National Women Safety Policy and the time by which the same is likely to be started?**

(a) and (b): The Ministry of Women and Child Development consulted the Ministry of Home Affairs in preparation of a scheme with action plan therein for safety and security of women, and for empowerment of women. The Government has approved implementation of the same as an umbrella scheme Mission Shakti by the Ministry of Women and Child Development for safety and security of women, and for empowerment of women. As per available information, Mission Shakti envisages a unified citizen-centric lifecycle support for women through integrated care, safety, protection, rehabilitation and empowerment as they progress through various stages of their life. The scheme tenure is from 2021-22 till 2025-26.
