CITIES/TOWNS COVERED UNDER AMRUT

NO. 326. SHRI CHANDESHWAR PRASAD:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of cities/towns covered under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) in Bihar to promote planned integrated development of cities; and
- (b) the details of the financial outlay for AMRUT projects during the year 2021-22?

ANSWER

- (a): A total of 27 cities /town of the State of Bihar have been covered under Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT).
- (b): Under AMRUT, financial outlay for projects have been earmarked for the entire Mission period. It has not been earmarked year-wise. The total approved State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) for all the States/ Union Territories (UTs) for the entire Mission period amounts to ₹77,640 crore, which include ₹35,990 crore of committed Central Assistance. So far, Central Assistance amounting to ₹30,295 crore have been released to States/ UTs for AMRUT projects.

The approved SAAP of State of Bihar amounts to ₹2,469.77 crore, which include committed Central Assistance of ₹1,164.80 crore. So far, Central Assistance amounting to ₹1,055.87 crore have been released to the State of Bihar for AMRUT projects.
