- (c) whether the Government has sought any proposal from the Government of Maharashtra for setting up of a large industrial unit in Nanded; and

(a) to (d): The primary responsibility of industrial development rests with the State Governments. The Union Government supplements their efforts through various schemes launched by it for different sectors with a view to promote industrialization.

Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI), Government of India has sanctioned an Agro Processing Cluster (APC), namely, M/s India Mega Agro Anaj Limited under "Creation of Agro Processing Clusters Scheme" on 15.3.2018, at MIDC, Krushnoor, Nanded District with project cost of Rs.30.99 Crores and grant-in-aid of Rs.10 Crores. The Ministry has also sanctioned 5 food processing units under the "Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation of Infrastructure (CEFPPC) Scheme" with a total project cost of Rs.37.52 crores and grant-in-aid of Rs.9.14 crores in the above said Agro Processing Cluster.
