SHORTAGE OF GUARDS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether goods trains are being run during night hours without guards and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether there is a shortage of guards as per the claims made by Moradabad Division and if so, the facts thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is also contemplating on running trains without guards;
- (d) if so, whether the Government has taken any steps in this matter till now and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether such a situation be a reasons for any major railway incident and if so, the details thereof?

(a): Some goods trains are being run without guards during night hours in case of operational exigencies with extensive safety precautions as laid down under General and Subsidiary rules (G&SR). (b): Presently there is some shortage of Guards. Against the total sanctioned strength of 843 Guards, currently there is vacancy of 169 Guards in Moradabad Division.

(c) & (d): End of Train Telemetry (EoTT) system has been provided as a Pilot Project on some of the freight trains.

(e): No untoward incident has been reported in the last three years on this account.
