(b) the details of new airport proposed to be set up in near future in the country,

(c) the details of the international airports proposed to be developed/set up in the country, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a): The total number of functional airports in the country is 130 out of which, 29 airports are International airports. A statement indicating State-wise number of airports/international airports is at Annexure.

(b): Government of India (GoI) has accorded 'in-principle' approval for setting up of 21 Greenfield Airports across the country namely Mopa in Goa, Navi Mumbai, Sindhudurg and Shirdi in Maharashtra, Bijapur, Hassan, Kalaburagi and Shimoga in Karnataka, DABRA (Gwalior) in Madhya Pradesh, Kushinagar and Jewar (Noida) in Uttar Pradesh, Dholera and Hirasar in Gujarat, Karaikal in Puducherry, Dagadarthi, Bhogapuram and Orvakal in Andhra Pradesh, Durgapur in West Bengal, Pakyong in Sikkim, Kannur in Kerala and Hollongi (Itanagar) in Arunachal Pradesh. Out of these, 08 airports namely Sindhudurg, Shirdi, Kalaburagi, Kushinagar, Orvakal, Durgapur, Pakyong and Kannur have become

(c): Declaration of an airport as International Airport depends upon traffic potential and demand from airlines for operation of international flights, besides various other requirements such as availability of Ground Lighting Facilities, Instrument Landing System for operation of aircrafts at night, adequate runway length to cater to medium capacity long-range aircraft or equivalent type of aircraft, availability of Customs, Immigration, Health and Animal & Plant
