†3571. SHRI SADASHIV KISAN LOKHANDE:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any action is being taken under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) in the country especially in Shirdi Parliamentary Constituency and other backward areas of Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details of the latest position as on date especially in the said Constituency and other backward areas; and
- (c) the details of central funds allotted and utilized along with the number of beneficiaries during the last three years and the current years, year and State-wise?

ANSWER

(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c) Since August, 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal after subsuming erstwhile National Rural Drinking Water Supply (NRDWP) to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including those in Ahmednagar District of Shirdi Parliamentary Constituency and other backward areas of Maharashtra, by 2024.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, out of 18.94 Crore rural households in the country, 3.23 Crore (17%) households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then tap water connection has been provided to additional 6.00 Crore (31.08%) rural households. Thus, as on 21.03.2022, out of 19.32 Crore rural households in the country, 9.24 Crore (47.38%) households are reported to have provision of tap water supply in their homes. States-wise and year-wise details of rural households with provision of tap water supply, are at **Annex-I**

Similarly, in Maharashtra, 48.44 lakh (33.16%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, tap water connections has been provided to additional 53.37 lakh (36.54%) rural households. Thus, as of 21.03.2022, out of total 146.09 lakh rural households in Maharashtra, provision of tap water supply has been made to 101.81 lakh (69.69%) households.
