**REGISTERED MSMEs IN WEST BENGAL**

3591. SHRI RAJU BISTA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of MSMEs registered in the districts of Darjeeling and Kalimpong during the last three years;
- (b) the details of funds/financial support provided by the Union Government to the MSME sector in the State of West Bengal and in the aforesaid districts during the last three years; and
- (c) the details of programmes and projects under which funds/financial support can be applied for new MSME Start-ups?

- (a): The details of MSMEs registered in the districts of Darjeeling and Kalimpong during the last three years are as at Anneure-I.
- (b): The details of assistance provided to West Bengal including the districts of Darjeeling and Kalimpong during the last three years under Credit Guarantee Scheme for Subordinate Debt (CGSSD) and Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), are at Annexure-II.
- (c): As informed by Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT), Startup India initiative was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. The flagship initiative aims to build a strong ecosystem for nurturing innovation and startups in the country that will drive sustainable economic growth and generate large-scale employment opportunities. The Action Plan comprises 19 action items spanning across areas such as "Simplification and handholding", "Funding support and incentives" and "Industry-academia partnership and incubation". A total of 36,216 startups have been recognized by DPIIT from April 2020 to 14<sup>th</sup> March 2022. In addition to facilitation for recognition, the Government has been working concertedly to support startups through the various schemes of Startups India viz. Seed Fund, Tax exemption u/s 80 IAC and u/s 56, Patent application and IPR protection, easier public procurement norms, etc.
