(a) The funds allocated and utilised for construction of National Highways (NHs) in the State of Himachal Pradesh during each of the last three years and the current year are as follows:-

2018-19	2098.41	2076.06
2019-20	1207.74	1146.33
2020-21	1922.11	1921.92
2021-22 (Till February, 2022)	2834.42	2782.34

- (b) Total 60 works costing Rs. 17,931 crores have been sanctioned during the last three years and the current year. Out of these, 8 works have been completed and remaining are at various stages of construction/ award.
- (c) During the current Financial Year (FY),140 km of National Highways (NHs) have been constructed till 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 against the target of 122 km in the State of Himachal Pradesh.
