NO. 3624. SHRI RAMALINGAM S.:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
(a) the total number of cities under developed towns covered/included under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) across the country as on date, State-wise including Tamil Nadu;
(b) whether the Government has any proposal to include Mayiladuthurai in Tamil Nadu under AMRUT which is the oldest and under-developed town for the last thirty years; and
(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS
(SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)
(a): A total of 500 cities across all States/ Union Territories (UTs) have been covered under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). Number of cities covered State/UT wise under AMRUT is given at ANNEXURE - I.
(b) \& (c): There is no proposal to cover Mayiladuthurai in Tamil Nadu in AMRUT scheme. However, Government has launched AMRUT 2.0 on 01 October, 2021 for the period of 05 years i.e. from the financial year 2021-22 to the financial year 2025-26. AMRUT $\mathbf{2 . 0}$ is designed to provide universal coverage of water supply through functional taps to all households in all the statutory towns in the country and coverage of sewerage/septage management in $\mathbf{5 0 0}$ cities covered in first phase of the AMRUT scheme. All the statutory towns in the country including Mayiladuthurai town are covered under AMRUT 2.0.
