**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS**

**be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the new expressway projects accorded approval by the Government during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;**
- (b) the number of expressways completed so far along with the expenditure incurred thereon during the said period, State/UT- wise;**
- (c) the number of such pending projects along with the reasons therefor;**
- (d) the time by which these pending projects are likely to be completed; and**
- (e) whether the Government proposes to establish Expressways Authority on the pattern of National Highways Authority of India and if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) to (d) Ahmedabad-Vadodara Expressway, Eastern Peripheral Expressway and Delhi-Meerut Expressway have been completed and construction of Dwarka Expressway is in advance stage. As part of Phase I of Bharatmala Pariyojana, five Expressways of about 2500 km length with cost of Rs. 1.65 lakh crore, namely Delhi-Vadodara-Mumbai Expressway, Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway, Lucknow-Kanpur Expressway, Bengaluru-Chennai Expressway and Ahmedabad-Dholera Expressway are in various stages of construction/award. All the works identified under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I, including expressways, are targeted for completion by 2026-27.**
