(a) to (c): The Government has notified the National Policy on Biofuels - 2018 (NPB) on 4th June 2018 which envisages production of biofuels from non-edible oil seeds bearing trees (Tree Borne Oilseeds (TBOs)) / crops such as Pongamia pinnata (Karanja), Melia azadirachta (Neem), castor, Jatropa Carcus etc. and cellulosic and lignocellulosic materials such as wood waste, agricultural and forestry residues, grasses, algae, etc. which are found in abundance in forest and agriculture areas. Government has also notified Pradhan Mantri JI-VAN Yojana for providing financial support to promote Second Generation (2G) ethanol production from cellulosic and lignocellulosic feedstock. The NPB & Pradhan Mantri JI-VAN Yojana are applicable all over the country including Gumla and forest rich areas of Jharkhand.
