### RENEWABLE ENERGY PARKS

#### 3661. SHRI GIRISH CHANDRA

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state

- (a) whether the Government has considered setting up of renewable energy parks in the country as a part of 'Make in India' initiative to boost self sufficiency;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- c) whether any such park has been proposed to be established across the country particularly in the State of Uttar Pradesh; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

## ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER

## (SHRI R.K. SINGH)

- (a)&(b) The Government is implementing a scheme for setting up of 50 Solar Parks of aggregate capacity 40,000 MW in the country. These parks are meant to provide developed infrastructure to facilitate installation of solar power projects. Central Financial Assistance of up to Rs. 25 Lakhs for preparation of Detailed Project Report and Rs. 20 Lakhs per MW or 30% of the project cost, whichever is lower, is provided for development of such Parks under the scheme.
- (c)&(d) As on 28.02.2022, the Government have sanctioned 56 solar parks of cumulative 38,266 MW capacity in 15 States in the country including Uttar Pradesh under the scheme. The details of 7 solar parks with a total sanctioned capacity of 3805 MW in the State of Uttar Pradesh are as under:
