## **COLD STORAGE FACILITY FOR COVID-19 VACCINE**

## 3708. SHRI VELUSAMY P.:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the existing cold storage facility is sufficient to store COVID-19 vaccine;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the steps taken by the Government to store additional vaccine?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): The existing cold chain storage facility is sufficient to store COVID-19 vaccines, there are a total of 305 Walk-in Coolers (WICs), 100 Walk-in Freezers (WIFs), 55,442 Ice Lined Refrigerators (ILRs), 50,881 Deep Freezers (DFs) and 528 Solar Direct Drives (SDDs) across more than 29,000 cold chain points in the country.
