STATUS OF NIRBHAYA FUND

†3712. SHRI JASWANT SINGH BHABHOR:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and current status of the Nirbhaya Fund with regard to Dahod district of Gujarat;
- (b) the increase in the amount of this fund with regard to Dahod district through the allocation made in the finance budget during the last three years; and
- (c) the rank-wise position of the States in terms of spending the allocated amount under Nirbhaya Fund, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) & (b): In case of all schemes / projects under Nirbhaya Fund except under One Stop Centre (OSC) and Universalisation of Women Helpline (WHL) Schemes of this Ministry, the funds are released to the States/ UTs for implementation. Hence, the district-wise data with regard to overall allocation to Districts under Nirbhaya Fund is not maintained. However, under the Scheme of One Stop Centre (OSC), an amount of Rs. 88.75 Lakhs has been released to Dahod District of Gujarat. Under WHL Scheme, the fund is released to the Districts designated by the State for running the WHL. In Gujarat, the WHL is being run from Ahmedabad District.
- (c): The State/ UT-wise details of funds released and utilized for various projects/ schemes under Nirbhaya Fund are at **Annexure**.
