(a) whether the number of air passengers from Delhi and Mumbai is continuously decreasing and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the Government proposes to take any step to increase the number of air passengers; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): The month-wise number of passengers handled by Delhi and Mumbai airports from January 2020 to December 2021 is given in Annexure-I. Delhi and Mumbai Airports witnessed decline in passenger traffic during successive waves of COVID-19.
- (b) and (c): Various steps taken by the Government to improve air connectivity, are as under:
- i) Ministry of Civil Aviation has launched Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) on 21-10-2016. as a market driven scheme. ii) Under this scheme, 403 RCS routes connecting 65 airports including 8 heliports

& 2 water aerodromes have been operationalized as on 31.01.2022.

iii) Covid guidelines/protocols for the Airline are framed in consultation with Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) and Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) to boost confidence of the air travellers during COVID-19 pandemic.

iv) The other steps include e-boarding, web check-in, contactless dropping of baggage, etc.
