MEDICAL OXYGEN PLANTS

3789 SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of oxygen plants installed and functioning in the country as on date, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has any plan to set up medical oxygen plants in each district of the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the timeline fixed for the purpose;
- (d) whether the Government has launched any comprehensive mission to encourage entrepreneurship and generate employment in health sector keeping in view acute shortage of manpower; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE

- (a) to (c): The Government of India has sanctioned 1561 Pressure Swing Adsorption (PSA) oxygen generation plants. These include 1225 PSA plants which have been installed and commissioned under PMCARES Fund in every district of the country. Additionally, 336 PSA Plants are set up by PSUs of Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Ministry of Power, Ministry of Coal, Ministry of Railways etc. As on date 1541 out of 1561 PSA plants have been commissioned. State/UT-wise details of PSA plants sanctioned and commissioned across the country is placed at Annexure.
- (d) & (e) The Government of India has provided the necessary financial and technical assistance to all States/UTs in building up the oxygen infrastructure. Under Emergency Response Package (ECRP)-I & II, the Government has provided Rs. 15,000 Crore and Rs 23,123 Crore respectively to the states for augmentation of health infrastructure, oxygen supported beds, isolation beds, ICUs & Human Resources etc.
