**IMPLEMENTATION OF AYUSH SCHEMES/PROGRAMMES**

**3798. SHRI ADHIR RANJAN CHOWDHURY:**

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) the AYUSH schemes/programmes currently being implemented by the Government across the country, stream-wise and State-wise including West Bengal;
- (b) the funds allocated/financial assistance extended for the implementation of the said schemes during the last three years, State/UT-wise and year-wise; and
- (c) the targets set for these Centrally Sponsored Schemes along with the success achieved in the implementation of these schemes?

**ANSWER**

(a)& (b) Ministry of Ayush is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) though States/UTs including West Bengal for development and promotion of AYUSH systems. Grant-in-aid is provided to States/UTs as per the proposals submitted by the State/UT Governments including West Bengal through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). The funds allocated/released as per the proposal received from States/UTs including West Bengal during the last three years, State/UT-wise and year -wise is furnished at **Annexure-I**.

(c) Under NAM, grant-in-aid is being provided to State/UT Governments for different activities as per their proposed State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). Since implementation of the programme comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments, no target has been fixed by Government of India for different States/UTs. However, resource pool with respect to NAM has been communicated to each State/UT Governments as per the defined criteria of NAM guidelines. Accordingly, States/UTs are required to prepare their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per their requirements in accordance with NAM guidelines. The status of major activities supported under NAM from 2014-15 to 2020-21 is furnished at **Annexure-II**.

**The status of major activities supported under NAM from 2014-15 to 2020-21**

- (i) 104 units supported for setting up of up to 50 bedded Integrated AYUSH hospitals
- (ii) 296 AYUSH Hospitals and 4717 AYUSH dispensaries have been supported for Up-gradation of infrastructure and other facilities
- (iii) 2865 PHCs, 837 CHCs and 349 DHs have been supported under co-location for recurring assistance of medicines and contingency on an average in each year
- (iv) 869 AYUSH Hospitals and 13416 AYUSH dispensaries have been supported for supply of essential AYUSH medicines on an average in each year.
- (v) 11 units supported for establishment of New AYUSH Educational Institutions
- (vi) 72 Under-Graduate and 33 Post-Graduate AYUSH Educational Institutes have been supported for Upgradation of infrastructure, Library and other things
- (vii) 36 ASU & H Pharmacies and 29 Drug Testing Laboratories have been supported for strengthening.
- (viii) 1965 Yoga Wellness Centres have been supported.
- (ix) 4448 AYUSH Health & Wellness Centres have been supported.
- (x) 512 AYUSH Gram units have been supported.
