- (a) the details of the proposed projects like building dams, recycling plants, development of ghats, etc. on Gomti river in Jaunpur district;
- (b) the time by which the Government intends to complete all the proposed projects on the Gomti river in Jaunpur district; and
- (c) the funds spent by the Government for the said projects?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): A project for pollution abatement of river Gomti has been taken under Namami Gange Programme. The project is for creation of Interception and Diversion (I&D) structures for the drains falling in the Gomti river and a Sewage Treatment Plant(STP) of 30 MLD in Jaunpur town. The sanctioned cost of the project is Rs 206.05 crores including Operation and Maintenance (O&M) cost for 15 years, out of which, an expenditure of Rs. 92.04 crores has been made.

Bajrang Ghat, Hanuman Ghat and River Front Development (RFD) works at Jaunpur are being developed on the Gomti river at a cost of Rs. 8.05 crores, out of which, an expenditure of Rs. 1.18 crores has been made.

The above projects are likely to be completed by June, 2022.
