Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the key objectives and features of the Swadesh Darshan scheme (SDS) along with the details of sanctioned projects under Eco Theme under SDS;
- (b) the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for major ongoing infrastructural development projects in the State of Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Uttar Pradesh and NCT of Delhi;
- (c) the details of funds allocated for the said States under SDS towards strengthening Tourism infrastructure through various spiritual circuits; and
- (d) the details of Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs), in US\$ from Tourism in the said States during the last three years and the current year?

#### ANSWER

#### MINISTER OF TOURISM

## (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (d): The major objective of the 'Swadesh Darshan' scheme includes development of circuits with tourist potential in a planned and prioritized manner, promote cultural value of the country to generate livelihoods in the identified regions, enhancing the tourist attractiveness in a sustainable manner by developing world class infrastructure etc. The Ministry of Tourism under its schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations/Central Agencies etc. for development of tourism infrastructure in the country. The projects under these schemes are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable Detailed Project Reports (DPR), adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier etc. The details of the projects sanctioned in the country under PRASHAD scheme and various themes including eco and spiritual themes in Swadesh Darshan scheme is at annexure I.

The Ministry of Tourism has not sanctioned any project in Delhi under Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD schemes however the details of the projects sanctioned in Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Uttar Pradesh is at annexure II.

The Ministry of Tourism do not maintain State –wise Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs). However, the details of Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs), in US\$ from Tourism in the country from 2017 to 2020 is at Annexure- III.
