**Green Belt Areas**

3997.SHRI NAYAB SINGH:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the initiative being taken by the Government for insuring larger green belt areas in urban areas under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) mode;
- (b) whether the Government has identified newly developed green belt areas in rural and urban areas of the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Haryana?

**ANSWER**

(a) to(c) The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change supports the States/Union Territories for carrying out afforestation activities in both forest and non-forest land including Urban and Rural areas under National Mission for a Green India (GIM) and CAMPA. Further, afforestation is being carried out by the States/Union Territories under various schemes of Central Government and State Government. As per report compiled in the Ministry under twenty-point programme, afforestation is being taken up annually over 2.0 million ha since 2019-20. Details of fund released/disbursed under GIM and CAMPA including Haryana is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

In addition, the Ministry has also launched Nagar Van Yojana (NVY) for providing wholesome healthy living environment, and contributing to growth of Smart, Clean, Green, Sustainable and Healthy cities. NVY envisages developing 400 *Nagar Vans* and 200 *Nagar Vatikas* in the country during the period of 2020-21 to 2024-25 with an objective to significantly enhance the tree outside forests and green cover, enhancement of biodiversity and ecological benefits to the urban and peri-urban areas apart from improving quality of life of city dwellers. So far, a total of 65 projects have been sanctioned in 22 States including Haryana. The State-wise details of Nagar Van projects sanctioned under Nagar Van scheme are given in **Annexure-II**.
