PRESERVATION OF KALARIPAYATTU

Will the Minister of **CULTURE** be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has any scheme for preserving Kalaripayattu which is a martial art designed for the ancient battlefield (the word "Kalari" meaning "battlefield"), with weapons and combative techniques that are unique to India; and
- b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) In order to preserve and promote the rich and diverse Intangible Cultural Heritage of India, a scheme titled "Safeguarding the Intangible Cultural Heritage and Diverse Cultural Traditions of India" is being run by Sangeet Natak Akademi, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India. However, there is no specific scheme for preserving 'Kalaripayattu' martial art. If a proposal is brought before the Ministry of Culture, we will consider it in terms of rules laid down for the same.
