Ministry of Tourism undertakes (a) to (e): The holistic promotion of various tourism destinations and products of the country. The Ministry of Tourism is promoting Thiruvarur globally through its www.incredibleindia.org. The Ministry also promotional website: State financial assistance to the **Governments/UT** provides Administrations under its 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) scheme for development of tourism infrastructure with the objective of integrated development of identified pilgrimage and heritage destinations. In addition, the Ministry 'Swadesh Darshan' scheme has also sanctioned under its infrastructure projects in the country covering various themes including Spiritual, Buddhist, Krishna, Ramayana, Teerthankar & Heritage. The details of the projects sanctioned under PRASHAD scheme and Spiritual, Buddhist, Krishna, Ramayana, Tirthankara and Heritage themes of Swadesh Darshan scheme is annexed.
