Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission (UGC) honours educational institutions for their outstanding work in the field of education and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of highest status given to educational institutions by NAAC; and
- (c) the names of educational institutions which have been awarded the highest status by NAAC during the last five years and the current year?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (Dr. SUBHAS SARKAR)

- (a): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is an autonomous body established by UGC to assess and accredit institutions of higher education in the country. NAAC assesses and accredits higher educational institutions, who apply for NAAC accreditation, using seven identified criteria to serve as the basis of its assessment procedures viz., Curricular Aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, Consultancy and Extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Student Support and Progression, Governance, Leadership and Management and Institutional Values and Best Practices.
- (b): As informed by UGC, the details of highest status (CGPA 3.01 and above) are as follows:
