Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of centres being run by the Sports Authority of India in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the total number of posts of coaches sanctioned and lying vacant in these centres at present;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to fill all the vacant post of coaches; and
- (d) the funds sanctioned, allocated and spent for the development of sports in Rajasthan during the last five years?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

- (a) Sports Authority of India (SAI) implements the following Sports Promotional Schemes across the country to identify talented sportspersons in the various age groups and nurture them to excel at national and international levels:-
 - (i) National Centres of Excellence (NCOE)
 - (ii) SAI Training Centre (STC)
 - (iii) Extension Centre of STC
 - (iv) National Sports Talent Contest (NSTC)

A total of 188 Centres including NCOEs, STCs, Extension Centres of STC, NSTC Scheme etc. are functional for

implementation of above Sports Promotional Schemes of SAI. The State-wise details are at Annexure.

(b) & (c) The details of the sanctioned post of coaches and the vacant posts in various SAI centres are as under:
