**4218. MS. DEBASREE CHAUDHURI:**

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), Self Help Groups (SHGs) and Producers Cooperatives benefitted under the Prime Minister Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PM-FME), State-wise;
- (b) the number of existing micro food processing enterprises which have been provided with financial, technical and business support for upgradation under the scheme along with the details regarding the support provided, State-wise;
- (c) the capacity building measures undertaken till now to impart skill training, technical knowledge on food safety, standards and hygiene and to improve quality under the scheme; and
- (d) the amount of allotted funds utilized under the scheme, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES

- (a): The State-wise number of applications received from Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), Self Help Groups (SHGs) and Producers Cooperatives under the Prime Minister Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PM-FME) are at **Annexure-I**.
- (b): The State-wise number of existing micro food processing enterprises which have been provided with financial support for the upgradation under the scheme are at **Annexure-II**.
- (c): Under capacity building component of the PMFME Scheme, 760 training modules for various food products have been prepared. Further, 455 Master Trainers (MTs) and 667 District Level Trainers (DLTs) and 741 District Resource Persons (DRPs) have been trained on EDP & various food domains including food safety, standards and hygiene. 1225 Beneficiaries in 13 States/UTs have been trained on EDP and various food products including food safety, standards, and hygiene.
