(a) to (b): Government is implementing the restructured National Bamboo Mission(NBM) from the year 2018-19 for developing the bamboo value chain for connecting bamboo growers to the market (industry). Under the scheme, assistance is provided to Govt/Private Agencies including entrepreneurs for establishing value addition, waste management and micro/medium processing units. The details of pattern of assistance given under NBM is at **Annexure I.**

(c): So far, 380 numbers of product development and processing units including micro/medium processing units have been set up since the inception of the scheme.
