PMGSY IN ODISHA

4237. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the names and the number of schemes sanctioned under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) (I-III) Phases in Odisha;
- (b) the roads sanctioned under all three phases of the said yojana and their work progress report in each District of Odisha;
- (c) the details of the amount allocated to Odisha under the said scheme; and
- (d) whether various such schemes are pending for years due to paucity of funds and if so, the time by which the said schemes are targeted to be completed?

(a)& (b) In the State of Odisha, 71,766 km road length has been sanctioned under various interventions/ verticals of PMGSY and out of which, 64,688 km road length has been completed as on 23rd March 2022.

The details of work under various interventions/ verticals of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) are as under: -

*Balance road length is less than the difference of sanctioned and completed length due to the reasons that some projects were completed with less than the sanctioned length due to reduction in road length, change in alignment, construction of part length by other agencies, etc.

(c) A sum of Rs.21,630.75 crore has been released as central share of programme fund as on 23rd March 2022 and an expenditure of Rs.28,545.28 crore (including state share) has been incurred towards implementation of the PMGSY in the State of Odisha.

(d) No Sir. There is no paucity of funds under PMGSY. As on 01.04.2021, the state had an unspent balance of Rs.1,368.88 crore (excluding Security Deposits). Rs.400 crore central funds were released to the state during the financial year 2021-22. The unspent balances as on 23 March 2022 (including state share) with the state is Rs. 653.15 crore. The Government has recently extended the timeline for completion of PMGSY-I, II and Road Connectivity Project Left Wing Extremism Affected (RCPLWEA). PMGSY-I&II are now targeted for completion by September 2022. RCPLWEA is targeted for completion by March 2023. The timeline for completion of PMGSY-III is March 2025.
