- a) whether a large number of farmers are being benefitted by the National Food Mission;
- b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) to (c) Yes Sir. The Government is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) of National Food Security Mission (NFSM) benefiting farmers in 28 States and 2 Union Territories viz; Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh. Under the scheme, assistance is provided to farmers for interventions like cluster demonstrations on improved package of practices, demonstrations on cropping system, seeds of High Yielding Varieties (HYVs)/hybrids, improved farm machineries/tools, water saving devices, micro nutrients & plant protection chemicals, processing & post-harvest equipments, trainings to the farmers etc. The expenditure on subsidy is shared between centre & state government on 60:40 for general states, 90:10 for North Eastern states & Hilly states and 100% Central share in case of Union Territories. The state-wise release of funds for under various components of NFSM during last 3 years are at Annexure.
