PMGSY IN UTTAR PRADESH

4346. SHRI GIRISH CHANDRA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of new roads selected under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in the State of Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the funds allocated, released and utilized for implementation of the yojana in Uttar Pradesh during the current financial year;
- (c) the length of roads constructed in rural districts of Uttar Pradesh under PMGSY during the last three years; and
- (d) the number of habitations provided access to roads under the yojana?

(a) The State of Uttar Pradesh has been allocated road length of 18,937.50 Km under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana phase III (PMGSY-III), against which, 2,534 number of road works measuring 18,770.17 Km have already been sanctioned to the State till 24th March, 2022 as per the following details :-

(b) A sum of Rs. 1,418.55 crore were released as central share and expenditure (including state share) of Rs. 1,840.98 crore was incurred for implementation of PMGSY in Uttar Pradesh during the current year till 23rd March, 2022.

(c) The details of road length constructed in the districts of Uttar Pradesh under PMGSY during the last three years and current year (as on 23.03.2022) are as under:

(d) Since inception till 23rd March, 2022, a total of 1,55,770 habitations in the population category 250+ and 5,858 habitations in the population category 100-249 have been provided all weather road connectivity under PMGSY in various States/ UTs. In the State of Uttar Pradesh, 11,748 habitations have been provided all-weather road connectivity during the said period.
