REPLACEMENT OF ASHOKA PILLAR ON UNIFORM BY DELHI POLICE

4368. SHRI KAUSHALENDRA KUMAR:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the logo of the Ashoka Pillar is replaced with India Gate on the uniform of Delhi Police and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether Delhi Police has taken the said decision on their Foundation Day on 16 February;

(c) if so, whether it is not a disrespect to the Ashoka Pillar; and

(d) if so, the opinion of the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a): No, Sir.

(b): State Police Forces, awarded with President's colour, are authorized to wear its Insignia with the approval of the Director General of Police concerned. As Delhi Police is also a recipient of President's colour, the Commissioner of Police, Delhi has issued orders to wear Insignia by all ranks from 16th February 2022. The Insignia does not replace or modify the existing uniform or logo of Delhi Police but is only an addition.

(c) and (d): Does not arise in view of reply to parts (a) and (b) above.
