- (a) the total number of vacancies in Non- Technical Popular Categories (NTPC);**
- (b) the total number of candidates shortlisted in these categories;**
- (c) whether the Government is aware of the protests by railway job aspirants against the recruitment rules; and**
- (d) whether the Government has amended the rules and if so, the details thereof?**

- (a): 35281 vacancies have been notified/modified in Non- Technical Popular Categories (NTPC) through Centralized Employment Notification (CEN) No. 01/2019.**
- (b): 705446 Roll Numbers were shortlisted in these categories for 2nd Stage Computer Based Test (CBT).**

(c) & (d): Candidates who appeared for 1st Stage CBT have raised some concerns after the results were announced and not against the recruitment rules. A Committee has been constituted to redress the concerns raised by candidates. The Committee has given its report which has been accepted. A notice containing decisions taken by the Committee and schedule for declaring revised result for all Pay Levels & of 2nd Stage CBT has been uploaded on official websites of Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) on 10.03.2022.
