URBAN DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

NO. 4614. SHRI SHRINIWAS PATIL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of urban development schemes for tier 3-4 cities like Satara and Karad under which the Government has allocated funds to various States, particularly Maharashtra along with the details of funds allocated there under during the last three years;
- (b) the details of the schemes that are fully and partially funded by the Government, separately; and
- (c) the details of role played by the Union Government, the State Governments and local bodies in selection of such schemes and finalizing expenditure to be incurred thereon?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (c) Urban Development is a State subject. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) assists the States / Union Territories (UTs) in urban development through its Missions / Schemes- Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0, Smart Cities Mission (SCM), Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) 2.0, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) and schemes in Urban Transport. The Government extends Central Assistance (CA) for implementation of these Schemes to the extent specified in the Guidelines of the respective Schemes with the remaining being contributed by States /UTs / Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). The details of these Schemes with the status of funds allocated during the last three years are given in the Annexure.

Annexure referred to in reply to part (a) to (c) of Lok Sabha Unstarred Question No 4614 regarding 'Urban Development Scheme' for answer on 31 March, 2022.

(i) Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation(AMRUT) 2.0

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) is being implemented in 500 selected cities including Satara in Maharashtra. The Mission focuses on the development of basic urban infrastructure in the sectors of water supply; sewerage and septage management; storm water drainage; non-motorised urban transport and development of green spaces and parks. Mission also mandates a set of 11 Reforms for all the Mission cities. Under the Mission the committed Central Assistance (CA) is ₹35,990 crore. AMRUT 2.0 has been launched on 1st October 2021 to provide tap water connections to all households in all towns and cities across the country including that of Maharashtra and universal coverage of sewerage and septage management in 500 AMRUT cities. Total indicative outlay for AMRUT 2.0 is ₹2,77,000 crore including central share of ₹76,760 crore (incl. ₹66,750 crore for AMRUT 2.0 projects) for five years from FY 2021-22 to FY 2025-26. Ongoing AMRUT Mission will be supported up to 31 March 2023 to achieve the objectives of the Mission. State-wise approved committed CA under AMRUT and AMRUT 2.0 is given below:

(ii) Smart Cities Mission

100 cities were selected through a two-stage challenge process, one at the State and other at national level for development as Smart Cities. In the first stage of the challenge process, States / Union Territories (UTs) shortlisted potential Smart Cities following objective criteria. In the second stage, these potential Smart Cities competed against each other in 4 rounds of competition held between January 2016 to June 2018. The implementation of SCM at the city level is done by a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) created for the purpose. Central Government is providing financial support to the extent of ₹48,000 crore over a period of five years i.e. ₹500 crore per city, on an average 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis is being contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB). In the State of Maharashtra,8 cities namely Aurangabad, Kalyan-Dombivali, Nagpur, Nashik. PimpriChinchwad, Pune, Solapur and Thane have been selected for development as Smart Cities. Government so far released ₹29,213.60 crore for 100 Smart Cities. State / City-wise detail of funds released under the Mission including Maharashtra are given below:

(iii) Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban(SBM-U) 2.0

Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) is being implemented in all the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) of the country. Allocation of Central Assistance (CA) under the Mission is made for the Mission period and not financial year-wise. State Governments / UTs can draw CA as per their requirements within the total funds allocated to them. ULBs identify projects as per the City Sanitation Action Plan (CSAP) and submit their demands to State Government. The State Government in-turn selects the projects for various ULBs keeping in the overall picture of the State and in consonance with the State Sanitation Action Plan. The selected projects after approval of the State High Powered Committee (SHPC) are submitted to the MoHUA for release of CA. The MoHUA releases the CA in conformity with the operational guidelines of SBM-U 2.0. Funds released, year-wise, to the States/ UTs are given below:

(iv) Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban(PMAY-U)

Under the vision of 'Housing for All', is supplementing the efforts of States / UTs by providing Central Assistance under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) for construction of houses for all eligible families / beneficiaries since 25.06.2015 in urban areas. Eligible beneficiaries can avail the benefit of PMAY-U through four verticals, i.e., Beneficiary-led Construction or enhancement (BLC); Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP); 'In-Situ' Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) and Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS). The first three verticals are Central Sponsored Schemes and CLSS is a Central Sector Scheme. Under the Mission, States / UTs have been delegated the powers for identification of beneficiaries and to appraise and approve project proposals based on demand assessed. States / UTs approach the MoHUA only for release of CA for projects approved at the State level. Under BLC & AHP verticals, the CA is Rs. 1.5 lakh per house while under ISSR vertical, the CA of Rs. 1.0 lakh per house provided by the Union Government to respective State/ UT Governments. Under CLSS vertical an interest subsidy on the housing loan is extended. Satara and Karad towns of Maharashtra are covered under PMAY-U. In Satara, 5,707 houses involving CA of ₹110.24 crore has been approved for construction during last three years (2018-2021)

and for which, CA of ₹75.90 crore has been released. In Karad, 1,066 houses have been sanctioned involving CA of ₹19.04 crore of which ₹13.60 crore has been released. The State / UT wise details CA approved and released during last three years under PMAY-U is given below:
