NIGHT LANDING FACILITY AT AIRPORTS

- (a) whether night landing facility is not available at several airports in the country including West Bengal and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to upgrade the technology to introduce night landing facility at the above airports;
- (c) if so, whether any time-limit has been fixed for this purpose; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a) All the operational airports in the country having scheduled flight operations have night landing facility, except in 23 airports, details of which are given in Annexure.
- (b) to (d) The upgradation of airports, including provision of night landing facility is a continuous process, which depends upon operational requirements, traffic demand, commercial feasibility etc. and varies from airport to airport in the country.
