NIGHT LANDING FACILITY AT AIRPORTS

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether night landing facility is not available at several airports in the country including West Bengal and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the Government proposes to upgrade the technology to introduce night landing facility at the above airports;**
- (c) if so, whether any time-limit has been fixed for this purpose; and**
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) All the operational airports in the country having scheduled flight operations have night landing facility, except in 23 airports, details of which are given in Annexure.

(b) to (d) The upgradation of airports, including provision of night landing facility is a continuous process, which depends upon operational requirements, traffic demand, commercial feasibility etc. and varies from airport to airport in the country.
