DEVELOPMENT OF BAGDOGRA AIRPORT

4752. SHRI RAJU BISTA

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the hassles faced by passengers passing through Bagdogra airport due to the lack of bigger airport terminal and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the details of the works undertaken for the development of Bagdogra Airport and funds allocated during the last three years;**
- (c) the details of funds allocated and spent under the UDAN scheme, state-wise; and**
- (d) the number of airports and airstrips which are operational under UDAN scheme in the North Eastern Region (NER)?**

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

(a): The existing building at Bagdogra Airport is designed for capacity of 0.75 Million Passengers Per Annum(MPPA). However, the actual footfall from 01.04.2021 to 28.02.2022 is 1.75 million. Land has been handed over to Airports Authority of India(AAI) by Government of West Bengal on 16th March 2022, to construct a new Terminal Building to ease out the congestion.;

(b): Allocation of Rs. 11.26 crore has been made for the development of Bagdogra Airport in the last 3 years. The details of work

completed/undertaken for the development of Bagdogra airport are as under:

i) Expansion work of existing Terminal Building having an area of 1710 sqm (i.e. 810+891 Sqm) in Phase I & II.

ii) Work of expansion of existing Terminal Building area of 546 Sqm.;

(c): The details of fund allocated and spent under the Regional Connectivity Scheme(RCS)-UDAN(Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik) Scheme, state-wise is attached as Annexure.;

(d): Nine(9) airports involved in the awarded routes under UDAN have been operationalized in the States of North Eastern Region by the Selected Airline Operators (SAOs) as on 24.03.2022.
