(a): The number of passengers travelled in public and private airlines during the last three years and current year is attached as Annexure.

⁽b) & (c): Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued the Air Transport Circular 02 of 2019 which is applicable to all Indian airline operators, scheduled foreign carriers operating from Indian territory and all airport operators on extending facilities/courtesies. The Circular lays down the facilities to be provided to the travelling public at the airports, particularly Senior citizens, expectants mothers, passengers with disability, first time travelers etc. Airlines and Airports extend protocols and courtesies to Members of Parliament to facilitate their travel. Instructions for facilitation of Members of Parliament are issued by this Ministry from time to time.
