- (a) the details and the present status of work on the Bengaluru-Mysuru ten-lane expressway project;**
- (b) whether the Government has received any suggestions/complaints to modify the design to meet the demands of some adjacent villages to provide access to the expressway;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken by the Government thereon; and**
- (d) the total cost of the project and the time by which the expressway is likely to be made operational?**

(a) to (d) The work for 6-laning of Bangalore-Nidagatta-Mysore road stretch has been awarded in two packages in February, 2018. The cost, length, scheduled completion etc. are as under:

Package	Stretch	Length (Km)	Physical progress	Cost (Rs. in cr.)	Scheduled completion date
Package-I	6 laning of Bengaluru to Nidagatta of NH 275	56.20	90%	3,501	May, 2022
Package-II	6 laning of Nidagatta to Mysuru of NH 275	61.10	85%	2,920	September, 2022

Some requests for providing crossing facilities were received. In accordance with the contract provisions, feasibility at site and the requests received, a total of 74 underpasses and 12 overpasses have been provided all along the access controlled highway to facilitate the crossing of adjacent villages from one side of service road to another side of service road.
