PRIME MINISTER'S 15 POINTS PROGRAMME

- (a) whether under Prime Minister's 15 Point Programme no scheme for minority welfare has been implemented in Aurangabad district of Maharashtra and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether it is a fact that no meeting has been conducted to implement any minority scheme during the last three years and if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether due to indifferent attitude of district administration minorities have been deprived of the benefits of various schemes under PM's 15 points programme and if so, the details thereof?
