(a) & (b): Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport, Delhi is ranked among the top fifty best airports globally by 2021 Skytrax World Airport Awards. Further, Delhi Airport has won the 'Best Airport in India/Central Asia', 'COVID-19 Airport Excellence' and 'Best Airport Cleanliness in Central Asia and India' awards in the 2021 Skytrax World Airport Awards.

(c): Hyderabad, Mumbai and Bengaluru Airports also feature in Top 100 Airports list published by 2021 Skytrax World Airport Awards. Participation in the survey for ranking of airports is upto the airport operators, to guage their performance against the benchmark standards. In India, most of the airport operators participate in the Airports Council International (ACI)-Airport Service Quality (ASQ) survey.
