GRANTS TO AIIMS INSTITUTES

4861. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has been providing grants to the All India Institutes of Medical Science (AIIMS) in the country;
- b) if so, the details of amount sanctioned and released during the last three years, AIIMS-wise; and
- c) the details of steps taken for expansion, provision of new departments in the AIIMS, including AIIMS, Bhubaneswar during the last three years?

(a) to (c): The Government provides grants-in-aid to All India Institute of Medical Science (AIIMS), New Delhi and new AIIMS, which have been approved under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) and are functional or partially functional, to meet their operational expenditure. The details of grants-in-aid released to various AIIMS are at **Annexure-I**.

Capacities of various AIIMS are strengthened based on requirements of the Institute, subject to availability of budgetary resources. As far as AIIMS, Bhubaneswar is concerned, all the 18 speciality and 17 super-specialty Department envisaged for new AIIMS are functional. One Satellite Centre of the Institute has also been approved at Balasore in Odisha.
