Will the Minister of **Health and Family Welfare** be pleased to state:

- (a) the average bed strength and infrastructure facilities available for specialised care in all hospitals empanelled under the Ayushman Bharat scheme, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the number of claims availed by poor families for COVID-19 treatment and COVID-19 related illnesses as well as the trends in all claims availed for all illnesses during COVID-19 lockdown, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the number of fraudulent claims flagged by the Central Government for the year 2021-22, State/UT-wise?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) to (c): Private hospitals under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) are empanelled by States/UTs based on well-defined criteria laid down by National Health Authority (NHA). The criteria include, among others, minimum in-patient bed strength and speciality-wise infrastructure facilities including equipment. The average bed strength of hospitals empanelled under the scheme is 45.
- As of 28<sup>th</sup> January 2022, approximately 8.5 Lakh hospital admissions are authorized for the treatment of COVID-19 under the scheme. State/UT-wise details are at Annexure-I.

As of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022, the number of fraudulent transactions recorded at Empanelled Healthcare Providers in the year 2021-22 is 22,874. State/UT-wise details thereof are at Annexure-II.
