Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received a proposal from the Government of Andhra Pradesh seeking loan of Rs. 7500 crore for renovation and strengthening of existing Government Medical Colleges under Nadu-Nedu scheme of the State; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with timeline proposed for sanctioning of funds for the same?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a scheme for upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCIs) through construction of Super Speciality Block (SSB) and/or Trauma Centre/or other facilities under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). Further, two more Centrally Sponsored Schemes are administered by the Ministry for strengthening and upgradation of medical colleges by increasing MBBS and PG seats in existing medical colleges. There is no provision of granting loan under any Schemes of this Ministry for renovation and strengthening of existing Government Medical Colleges.
