- (a) the estimated time of completion of medical college in Jaunpur;
- (b) the number of proposed UG and PG seats in the said medical college;
- (c) the estimated total cost of construction of the said medical college;
- (d) whether the cost has increased due to delay in completion of the said medical college; and
- (e) if so, the reasons for delay and the amount of cost increased due to delay in completion of the same?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) Medical college at Jaunpur is a project of State Government of Uttar Pradesh and is not covered under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Ministry. The letter of permission for the academic year 2021-22 for starting the college with 100 MBBS seats has been granted by the National Medical Commission.

Further, as per information from the State Government Uttar Pradesh, the cost of project is Rs.554.1671 crore.
