5059. SHRI SANJAY BHATIA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up 300 more One Stop Centres in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise and location-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up such centre in Panipat also which comes under Karnal Parliamentary Constituency; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): As of now, 733 One Stop Centres (OSCs) have been approved by the Government for setting up in 36 States /UTs, out of which 704 are operational in 35 States /UTs, including one OSC in Panipat.

Further, the Government has decided to set up 300 more OSCs in the districts having higher rate of crime against women, bigger geographical area and in aspirational districts, in a phased manner during the period of 15th Finance Commission Cycle, i.e. up to 2025-26 in consultation with States / UTs. So far, no proposal for setting up of additional OSC in Panipat has been received from the State Government of Haryana.
