- (a) to (b) Yes Sir, National Museum, which comes under Central Vista Re-Development Project, possesses artefacts as old as 5000 years representing our diverse civilization. However, no manuscripts as old as 5000 years are available in the National Museum or in Jawaharlal Bhavan. Safety and security of artefacts is ensured through CCTV surveillance and by deploying CISF personnel on 24/7 basis.
