Recognition of Degrees and Diplomas of Foreign Universities

Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has developed any mechanism to categorize and recognize degrees and diplomas from different foreign universities and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the Government has the data of foreign students studying in India and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- **(a):** As per Gazette Notification No.(45)F.15-17/94-TS.IV(.) dated 13th March, 1995 those foreign qualifications which are recognized/ equated by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi are treated as recognized for the purpose of employment to posts and services under the Central Government.
- **(b):** As per the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) Report 2019-20, there are 49,348 Foreign National Students enrolled in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in the country.
