**Plantation of Sapling**

5180. SHRI HEMANT SRIRAM PATIL:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government ensures that new saplings are planted to replace the trees cut in the rural areas;
- (b) if so, the number of saplings planted during the last three years and the current year State-wise; and
- (c) the details of the amount spent during the current year, State-wise and year-wise?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Compensatory afforestation is one of the conditions against the forest land diverted and trees affected thereof, for which prior approval of the Central Government is accorded under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. In addition, State Forest Department also carry out afforestation in Gram samaj land on the request of concerned Gram Sabha.
- (b) The number of saplings planted under the Compensatory Afforestation during the last three years and the current year, State-wise is given in Annexure-I.
- (c) Amount spent during the current year, State-wise and year-wise is given in Annexure-II.
