(a) to (d) Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India administers various scheme components such as Cultural Function Production Grant, Repertory Grant, Cultural Organization with National Presence etc., under which grants are being given as financial assistance to the organizations to organise cultural events across the country including the States of Jharkhand, Bihar and Maharashtra. Seven Zonal Cultural Centres across the country play a key role in promotion of culture through the programmes decided in consultation with their member State Government. The concerned Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) of above mentioned three member states are as follows:-
