- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the estimated shortfall in revenue caused in the financial year 2017-18 as a result thereof?

(a) to (c): Rates of customs and excise duties are reviewed periodically as part of Union Budget exercise, taking into account relevant factors including revenue, interest of domestic producers and user industry, export promotion etc. Indirect tax revenue collection has grown consistently since 2017-18.
