- (a) whether the Government is running four years Integrated Teacher Education Programme for the last few years and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the institutions selected in Rajasthan for the implementation of the said programme;
- (c) whether the Government is paying full attention to the quality of education in two yearly and four yearly teacher's education programmes; and
- (d) if not, the steps being taken by the Government to improve the quality of education in these colleges?

(a) to (d) NCTE has notified a four-year Integrated Teachers Education Programme (ITEP) vide notification in the Gazette of India on 26.10.2021 to be offered in pilot mode initially in selected multi-disciplinary institutions across the country. However, NCTE has not invited applications from any of the institutes for the 4-Year ITEP. NEP recognizes that the teachers require training in high-quality content as well as pedagogy. NEP 2020 focuses on teacher education and by 2030, aims to move teacher education into multidisciplinary colleges and universities. With colleges and universities moving towards becoming multidisciplinary, the aim is to house outstanding education departments offering B.Ed., M.Ed., and Ph.D. degrees in education. 4-year integrated B.Ed. degree envisages to teach a range of knowledge content, pedagogy and provide strong practicum training.
